

## **Chapter 58. Sale of Alcoholic Beverages Near Churches, Public Schools and Public Hospitals<sup>1</sup>**

### **58.001 Order**

- (a) Whereas, section 109.33 of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code permits the Commissioners Court of a county of enact regulations, applicable in areas in the county outside an incorporated city or town, prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages by a dealer whose business is within 300 feet of a church, public school or a public hospital; and
- (b) Whereas, the measurement of the distance between the place of business where alcoholic beverages are sold and the church or public hospital shall be along the property lines of the street fronts and from front to front door, and in direct line across intersections; and
- (c) Whereas, the measurement of the distance between the place of business where alcoholic beverages are sold and the public schools shall be from the nearest property line of the public school to the nearest doorway by which the public may enter the place of business, along street lines and in direct line across intersections; and
- (d) Whereas, for any permit or license covering a premise where minors are prohibited from entering the premises under Section 109.53 of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code, the measurement of the distance between the premises and the public schools shall be along the property lines of the street fronts and from front door to front door, and in a direct line across intersections.
- (e) Now, therefore, be it resolved and ordered by the Travis County Commissioners' Court that the sale of alcoholic beverages by a dealer whose place of business or proposed place of business is within 300 feet of a church or public school or public hospital in Travis County, Texas be prohibited in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code. This order shall take effect immediately.
- (f) Ordered this 3 day of October, 1990.
