**Addendum to Defendant's §12.45 Motion--  
Defendant's Agreement and Waiver of the Right to Seek Expunction  
of Arrest Records and Files Relating to the Admitted, Unadjudicated Cause**

Before admitting that I, \_\_\_\_\_,  
am guilty of the charges alleged in cause number(s) \_\_\_\_\_,  
I desire to waive and do hereby  
knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily waive my right ever to seek expunction of any  
arrest record and file relating to this offense (these offenses).

To this end, I agree that once the trial court has lawfully taken the admitted,  
unadjudicated misdemeanor offense(s) into account under Texas Penal Code §12.45, it  
(they) "results (result) in a final conviction" within the meaning of the expunction  
statute and therefore cannot qualify for the statutory remedy of expunction.

This agreement and waiver of the right to seek expunction of arrest records and  
files relating to the admitted, unadjudicated offense(s) is made in exchange for the  
State's agreement to a Penal Code §12.45 disposition. I make this waiver after  
consulting my attorney and after being informed of the consequences of this waiver.

I request that this waiver and agreement be filed in the papers of this cause  
before I admit my guilt in the unadjudicated cause.

I further request that both the §12.45 motion and this addendum be reflected in  
the papers of the adjudicated cause, # \_\_\_\_\_, as a  
part of the formal judgment of conviction in that cause.
