**TRIAL COURT'S CERTIFICATION OF DEFENDANT'S RIGHT OF APPEAL**

- (1) within 30 days after the day sentence is imposed or suspended in open court, or after the day the trial court enters an appealable order; or
- (2) within 90 days after the day sentence is imposed or suspended in open court if the defendant timely files a motion for new trial

I have also been informed of my rights concerning any appeal of this criminal case, including any right to file a pro se petition for discretionary review pursuant to Rule 68 of the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure. I have been admonished that my attorney must mail a copy of the Court of Appeal's judgment and opinion to my last known address and that I have only 30 days in which to file a pro se petition for discretionary review in the Court of Appeals. Tex. R. App. P. 68.2. I acknowledge that, if I wish to appeal this case and if I am entitled to do so, it is my duty to inform my appellate attorney, by written communication, of any change in address at which I am currently living or any change in my current prison unit. I understand that, because of appellate deadlines, if I fail to timely inform my appellate attorney of any change in my address, I may lose the opportunity to file a pro se petition for discretionary review.
