STANDING ORDER FOR

APPLICATION FOR AND
REFUSAL OF IV-D CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES

All final orders, excluding modifications, that provide for child support to be paid through the local registry or the State Disbursement Unit shall be deemed to include an application for IV-D child support services provided by the County and the Office of the Attorney General of Texas, pursuant to Chapter 231 of the Texas Family Code. This ORDER shall apply to final orders rendered by the Travis County District Courts after the effective date of this ORDER.

Unless required to accept IV-D child support services pursuant to other laws, a child support obligee entitled to receive services pursuant to this ORDER may decline services by filing a written Refusal of Child Support Services with the District Clerk.


