**Emergency Standing Order Regarding Possession and Access of Children Pursuant to Existing Court Orders**

In response to the State of Disaster declared by the Governor and the growing concerns regarding the public health emergency caused by COVID-19 and resulting school closures, the Travis County Civil and Family Courts have adopted the following order concerning existing possession and access orders for children:

School closings, based on public health emergencies, do not alone modify existing court ordered periods of possession of children. Parties should continue to follow the originally published school calendar as if school were resuming and dismissing on that schedule.

Nothing in this Order is intended to prevent the request for emergency relief based on particular circumstances.

The Travis County Civil and Family courts will resume normal operations and in-person hearings on April 13, 2020, unless otherwise notified.
