Dear Ms. Lehmberg:

Texas Mutual's annual funding agreement with your office, as authorized by Chapter 2054 of the Texas Insurance Code, is set to renew on October 1, 2015. This letter is intended to postpone the renewal of that agreement to provide time to study the agreement and consider amendments to its terms in order to ensure that the will of the Texas Legislature (and other stakeholders concerned with opposing fraud in the workers' compensation system) continues to be carried out to the highest standards of prosecutorial conduct.

In the meantime, to avoid unnecessary hardship on your office and the county, Texas Mutual will cover the salaries and expenses of four county employees, through the end of the year, to continue their work prosecuting workers' compensation insurance fraud.
