A Travis County Grand Jury has decided that Austin Police Department (APD) Officer Martha Cameron will not face charges related to the death of James F. Sizer. Officers responded to Sizer's residence on March 6, 2015 in response to "shots fired" calls from Sizer and a neighbor. Finding Sizer standing outside on his driveway, Officer Cameron ordered Sizer to the ground, but Sizer did not comply. Officer Cameron then tased Sizer, causing him to fall and strike his head on the ground. Sizer was taken to North Austin Medical Center where he was treated and observed overnight before being taken to jail. Sizer later died in his home on March 14, 2015 due to complications of blunt force head trauma received when Sizer fell.

The Grand Jury heard approximately five hours of testimony from seven witnesses.
