David Green Found Guilty of Aggravated Sexual Assault & Aggravated Robbery Judge Sentences Green to 50 Years in Prison

(Austin, TX) A jury in Travis County this afternoon convicted 59 year-old David Green of Austin of Aggravated Sexual Assault and Aggravated Robbery. Green was sentenced to 50 years in prison by 331st District Court Judge Chantal Eldridge.

On the evening of December 21, 2018, a 19 year-old woman says she went to Davis White Northeast District Park on Crystalbrook Drive in East Austin. The victim told police she was approached by two men who chatted with her. She says David Green then put a knife to her neck and walked her to a playground area where both men sexually assaulted her. When the men left, the victim says Green took her phone and a necklace she was wearing.

After the verdict and sentence, Travis County District Attorney Margaret Moore said, "I am so very proud of this young woman. She showed great courage and eloquently described the horror of this crime. I hope this verdict assists in her healing."

The case was tried by Travis County Assistant District Attorneys Matt Campbell and Lindsay Richards.

The second defendant is awaiting trial.
