Travis County District Attorney Rosemary Lehmburg today issued the following statement:

In January of 2013, Frances Keller filed a court document containing an affidavit from Dr. Michael Mouw, an emergency room doctor who testified in her jury trial years earlier. At that time, I learned that Dr. Mouw had recanted his trial testimony regarding his examination of one of the child victims in the case.

In August, Judge Wilford Flowers conducted an evidentiary hearing in the case. At this hearing, Dr. Mouw testified that his trial testimony was incorrect and that he no longer agreed with some of his previous opinions. He also testified that he may have exaggerated his experience to the jury.

Given the crucial nature of Dr. Mouw's testimony in a child sexual abuse case, I agreed that there is a reasonable likelihood that his false testimony affected the judgment of the jury and violated Frances Keller's right to a fair trial.

Today, my office agreed that Keller should be released on bond pending the disposition of appellate review of this matter.

Daniel Keller has filed a similar court document. I have agreed that Dr. Mouw's testimony also violated his right to a fair trial, as we did in the Frances Keller matter, and will agree to his release on bond.

The Court of Criminal Appeals will review both cases. No further action or decisions on the case will be made until that review is finalized.
