Travis County Offices Closed Tuesday, January 16

TRAVIS COUNTY, Texas - Due to winter weather conditions, Travis County Judge Sarah Eckhardt has announced all Travis County offices and facilities will be closed on Tuesday, January 16, 2018. Essential County staff will continue to report to duty. Staff should contact their supervisor for questions related to their department's staffing needs. Additionally, based on Government Code 551.0411(b), the Travis County Commissioners Court will not convene Tuesday as previously posted, and will reschedule the court session once additional weather reports become available.

The public should avoid traveling unless absolutely necessary. Travis County will continue to monitor conditions and will provide updates as they become available and provide updates on the County's website at www.traviscountytx.gov and www.traviscountytx.gov/emergency-services.
