Fireworks Display Guidelines and Submittal Requirements

A completed permit application, associated fees, along with the following information is required in order to execute all commercial or consumer firework displays within unincorporated Travis County, Texas.

- A site plan identifying the shoot location, spectators, distances and hazards within the area must be submitted.
- A copy of current pyrotechnic operator license issued by the Texas State Fire Marshal.
- A list of fireworks (quantity and type) used in the display along with material safety data sheet (MSDS) for each.
- Provide time and duration of show.
- Provide proof of minimum public liability insurance policy for the principal sum of \$100,000.
- Provide safety plan
- If requesting a public display permit for 1.3G Explosives, include the State Fire Marshal's Office required permit (commercial only).

Please submit a complete application and supporting documents for review and approval prior to any scheduled event. Review and approval for flame effect, open flame performance, etc. will also require a detailed review. All shows must meet the State of Texas requirements along with Travis County.
