

**Summary of the Amendment to the Method of Distribution for Community Development Block Grant  
Disaster Recovery Program**

*Floods Occurring During May and October 2015*

The Texas General Land Office gave Travis County the task of developing a method of distribution for \$5,531,116 of Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The method of distribution identifies how much money will be allocated to eligible local government jurisdictions. Sixty-eight percent of the funds must be used for non-housing projects and 32% must be used for housing related projects. In November of 2016, the Method of Distribution was approved.

In October 2017, the Texas General Land Office notified Travis County that additional funds, in the amount of \$3,113,119, were available. The Method of Distribution, approved in November 2016, needs to be amended making the total funds available for the Method of Distribution \$8,644,235.

The draft amendment for the allocation of infrastructure and housing projects is:
