RECITALS

In accordance with the TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE ANN., §§ 152.011 through 152.018, the Commissioners Court has held a public hearing on the Proposed Salaries of the Elected Officials of the County and Precincts on July 13, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners Courtroom, 314 West 11th Street, Ned Granger Building, for which hearing a public notice as required by law has been published. The county and precinct elected officials have been notified of the meeting as required by law.

After careful consideration of the Proposed Salaries of the Elected Officials, the Commissioners Court adopted and approved an order approving the Salaries of the Elected Officials.

Having heard additional information on September 8, 2010, the Commissioners Court amended and approved the following revisions of the salaries of the following Elected Officials whose salaries are not subject to TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE ANN., §§ 152.011 through 152.018.

ORDER

The Commissioners Court of Travis County, Texas, makes the following End Notes are added at the end of the End Notes to Attachment A in the COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER SETTING SALARIES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2011:

7. The County Salary of the District Judges is the least compensation received by any of these officials. A supplement of **\$3,874.00** based on judicial longevity is added to and part of the salary of any District Judge if the judge has not been a district judge for at least 16 years but has been an active county court or probate judge in Travis County, has held an elected judicial position in Travis County or has been a District Judge in Travis County for a combined total of 16 years or more.
8. The County Salary of the District Judges is the least compensation received by any of these officials. A supplement of **\$5,000.00** is added to and part of the salary of to the District Judge selected as the administrative judge for the criminal courts by the District Judges presiding over criminal courts in Travis County.

END NOTES TO ATTACHMENT A

1. Travis County pays for health insurance for every county employee and elected official. If a county employee or an elected official had and continues to have other health coverage and has continuously declined this county coverage since September 30, 2003, that person may receive an additional \$184.86 per month which may, at that person's option, be added to that person's total annual FY 1011 salary or placed in an IRS approved flexible spending account for the reimbursement of health care or dependent care expenses.
2. The County Salary is the least compensation received by any of these officials. A supplement of \$3,874.00 based on judicial longevity is added to and part of the salary of any County Court at Law Judge and any Probate Judge if the judge has been an active county court or probate judge and held an elected judicial position in Travis County for at least 16 years.
3. As of January 1, 2010, the Probate Judge was elected Presiding Judge of the Statutory Probate Judges of Texas for another four year term. For the additional duties as Presiding Judge he is paid \$33,000 per year.
4. The County Salary is the least compensation received by any of these officials. A supplement of \$2,905.50 is added to the salary of a Justice of the Peace if the Justice has been an active Justice of the Peace and held an elected judicial position in Travis County for at least 16 years.
5. The salary of the County Judge includes \$4,800 for service on the Travis County Juvenile Board.
6. Pursuant to Texas Local Gov't Code § 152.052,
 - Commissioner Precinct 2 has requested that her FY 2011 compensation be the annualized amount of her FY 2010 salary plus the 2.5% increase \$88,812.00, and
 - Commissioner Precinct 3 has requested that her compensation for FY 2011 be the annualized amount for FY 2010 salary \$90,109.00.

RECITALS

By Commissioners Court Order dated September 28, 2010, the Commissioners Court has set the tax rates and levied taxes based on the tax requirements identified in the County budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010.

In this order, "Proposed Budget" means the budget that the Executive Manager, Planning and Budget of Travis County prepared for the period beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 and filed with this Commissioners Court, the County Clerk and the County Auditor on September 24, 2010.

Pursuant to Sections 1.0051 and 1.0052 of the Travis County Code, the Commissioners Court may amend that manual.

In accordance with TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE, Chapters 111.063 through 111.073, the Executive Manager, Planning and Budget of Travis County, has prepared the Proposed Budget and filed it with this Court, the County Clerk and the County Auditor on September 24, 2010.

By order made and entered into the Minutes of this Commissioners Court, a public hearing on the Proposed Budget was called to be held on September 28, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commissioners Courtroom, 314 West 11th Street, Ned Granger Building.

The Commissioners Court intends that the Proposed Budget includes certain interpretations about and restrictions on the use of the funds budgeted in the Proposed Budget. These interpretations and restrictions are included in the following documents:

- a) Budget Rules,
- b) Personnel Slot List which shows all authorized positions including New Positions,
- c) Revenue Estimate prepared by the County Auditor,
- d) Complete Financial Statement, and
- e) Changes to the Proposed Budget, which the Commissioners Court has made since it was filed.

After careful consideration of the Proposed Budget as modified by these restrictions, it appears to the Court that this Proposed Budget is in the best interests of the County for the period for which appropriations are made in it, and that this Proposed Budget should be adopted and approved.

ORDER

The Commissioners Court of Travis County, Texas, makes the following orders that relate to the adoption and implementation of the Travis County Budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011:

1. Chapter 22 of the Travis County Code is deleted,
2. The Budget Rules for FY 11 are added to the Travis County Code as Chapter 22 in the form approved on September 21, 2010, and
3. The budget for Travis County, Texas, for the period beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 includes the following documents, which were filed with the County Clerk and County Auditor on September 24, 2010 and are incorporated in it by reference:
 - 3.1 Proposed Budget at the department level which is managed at the line item level,
 - 3.2 Current Proposed Budget for Certificates of Obligation for FY 11 Issuances,
 - 3.3 Current Proposed Budget for voter authorized bonds,
 - 3.4 Personnel Slot List which includes New Positions
 - 3.5 Elected Officials salaries as stated in Order dated July 13, 2010, as amended September 28, 2010, setting these salaries,
 - 3.6 Chapter 22 of the Travis County Code which governs the expenditures of funds under the Proposed Budget,
 - 3.7 Auditor's Revenue Estimate and Complete Financial Statement,
 - 3.8 Reappropriated grant funds for the end of Fiscal Year 2010 not to exceed \$125,000,000 in accordance with the terms of the grant contracts, and

- 3.9 Motions to Amend the Fiscal Year 2011 Proposed Budget and Chapter 22 of the Travis County Code shown in Attachment B.
4. The budget for Travis County, Texas, for the period beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 includes the following documents, which are not yet available and will be filed with the County Clerk on or before November 30, 2010, and are incorporated in this order by this reference:
 - 4.1 A combined total of properly pre-encumbered balances at the end of the Fiscal Year 2010 and properly encumbered balances at the end of the Fiscal Year 2010, including balances initially pre-encumbered and encumbered prior to Fiscal Year 2010, to the extent that they do not exceed \$175,000,000 and are used for the purpose pre-encumbered or encumbered on or before September 30, 2010.
 - 4.2 Capital account balances as of September 30, 2010 to the extent that they do not exceed \$225,000,000.
 - 4.3 An amount of voter approved bonds and certificates of obligation to be issued that does not exceed \$150,000,000.
5. The total of adding the amounts referenced in 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.7, 3.8, and 3.9 and in 4.1, 4.2, and 4.3 of this order shall establish the total adopted budget for expenditures and is not to exceed **\$1,380,914,164**.
6. The budget for Travis County for the period beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 includes employee and retiree health and other benefits that are determined annually. The budget for Travis County for the period beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 is finally approved and adopted for that time period.
7. After receiving direction from the County Judge to do so, the Executive Manager, Planning and Budget shall file an official and approved copy of the Budget with the County Auditor and the County Clerk.
8. Expenditures of the funds of Travis County shall not be made, approved or paid from this date until September 30, 2011, unless the expenditures are in strict compliance with this budget, unless it is amended in compliance with the laws of Texas.
