Upon receipt of notice that it has been recommended for contract award (as the apparent low bidder), the Prime Contractor must fill out this certification and instruct all of its subcontractors to do the same. These certifications must be submitted together with, or prior to submission of, the executed contract.

Purpose: This certification addresses jobsite safety. It is used to verify that all construction workers working on County projects have received OSHA-10 training and that all safety managers or supervisors working on County projects have received OSHA-30 training.

The Contract Compliance Program will recommend that the contract not be awarded to a Prime Contractor who has not submitted completed OSHA Training Certifications (for itself and all subcontractors).
