Travis County Wage Law Compliance Certification?](#)**

Upon receipt of notice that it has been recommended for contract award, (as the apparent low bidder), the Prime Contractor must fill out this certification and instruct all of its subcontractors to do the same. These certifications must be submitted together with, or prior to submission of, the executed contract.

Purpose: This certification is part of pre-screening and is used to verify whether or not a contractor has violated any local, state, or federal wage laws, including the Davis-Bacon Act; National Labor Relations Act; Texas Labor Code, Chapter 61; Texas Property Code, Chapter 162; or Texas Government Code, Chapter 2258.

In paragraph two (2), you are asked to certify, or state, if you have either been adjudicated guilty, pled nolo contendere, or entered into a settlement agreement in a legal proceeding at least two times or more in the previous five (5) years. If you have, then the Contract Compliance Program *will recommend* that you be considered *non-responsible and disqualified* from the project.
