All Prime Contractors must fill out this certification, along with the Subcontractor Workforce Training Program Contact List, and submit them with their bid.

Purpose: This certification is used as an outreach tool. Primes are required to demonstrate efforts to hire students and graduates from DOL-registered Workforce Training Programs for each subcontracting opportunity identified in the solicitation.

Primes may satisfy this requirement by notifying three (3) or more subcontractors who hire students and graduates from County-approved (DOL-registered) programs. A Subcontractor Workforce Training Program Contact List form is included with this certification for your convenience. In addition, the Contract Compliance Program has created a database of all DOL-registered construction-industry Workforce Training Programs in the State of Texas. The database is searchable and filterable and includes the Program Name, Occupation Title, DOL/OA Program Manager, program address, contact information, and DOL Occupation Code.

If your efforts to contact three (3) or more subcontractors are unsuccessful and/or if you will self-perform all or a portion of the work, check the appropriate boxes and fill in the blanks in Paragraphs 4, 7, and 8. Please also consider sharing information about other, non-DOL-registered training programs from which you or your subs hire on a regular basis, as described in Paragraph 9.
