




Dear Mr. Conrad:

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) received the annual report for the Balcones Canyonlands Conservation Plan (BCCP) on January 31, 2014. The BCCP is required to provide to the Service each year a report of its activities for the prior fiscal year according to the terms and conditions of permit TE-788841-2 issued to both the City of Austin and Travis County. We have reviewed the annual report for compliance with the terms of your permit.

I want to thank the BCCP permittees for providing us with the report. I especially want to thank the BCCP for its commitment to public education and outreach.
