

BRAKER LANE NORTH EXTENSION SAMSUNG BLVD TO HARRIS BRANCH PKWY

ABOUT THE BRAKER LANE NORTH EXTENSION

A proposed new 4-lane roadway that extends Braker Lane from Samsung Boulevard to Harris Branch Parkway is currently being studied. The project would include new sidewalks, bike lanes, and storm water infrastructure. An environmental study and preliminary design underway in the Fall of 2016 is being funded through federal dollars administered by the Texas Department of Transportation. However, there is currently no funding identified for the construction of the proposed project.

WHY IS THE PROJECT NEEDED

The Austin area is growing and new infrastructure is needed to enhance safety and increase mobility of the public. As proposed, the Braker Lane North Extension would connect major employers in the area with new housing and commercial development, and also provide new opportunities to get around on foot or bike.
