


**BALCONES CANYONLANDS PRESERVE

The Ribelin Tract is located in the Bull Creek Macrosite, in western Travis County, north of FM 2222 and east of FM 620. It was acquired by Travis County in June 2004. Under the terms of the Balcones Canyonlands Conservation Plan (BCCP) permit issued to the City of Austin and Travis County by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) on May 2, 1996, the acquiring agency will complete an individual land management plan for each tract which will then be submitted to the USFWS for approval. Prior to submittal to USFWS, this draft land management plan document for the Ribelin Tract will be reviewed by the Scientific Advisory Committee, the Citizens Advisory Committee and available for public comments.

Until an individual land management plan is approved by USFWS for this tract, it is being managed under the “Land Management Plans and Guidelines” from the Habitat Conservation Plan in the BCCP Permit.
