Introduction

The Commissioners Court appointed a fifteen member Citizen Bond Advisory Committee (CBAC) in January 2017 to review and prioritize a proposed list of transportation, drainage, and parks and land conservation projects for either Certificates of Obligation (CO) funding in annual budgets or General Obligation (GO) funding that would require voter approval in a November 2017 election. Citizens could submit their comments in writing or give testimony in four different communication venues from March 9, 2017 through August 3, 2017.

- CBAC Citizen Communications: Twenty-six (26) people spoke directly to the CBAC during the time allocated for Citizens Communications at each of their work sessions. These were held from March to July 2017.
- Public Meetings: Approximately¹ 364 people attended and a total sixty-seven (67) people spoke at six (6) public meetings that were held at locations throughout the county in June 2017;. The meetings were held at *Manor New Tech High School* (18 attendees and 6 speakers); *Wells Branch MUD Community Center* (15 attendees and 8 speakers); *Del Valle ISD Opportunity Center* (63 attendees and 12 speakers); *Vandegrift High School* (26 attendees and 5 speakers); *Travis County Administration Building* (15 attendees and 6 speakers); and *Lakeway Activity Center* (227 attendees and 29 speakers).
- Written Communications: six hundred and twenty-seven (627) written comments were submitted to the CBAC through July 28, 2017.
- Public Hearing: Twenty-eight (28) people spoke to the Commissioners Court at a Public Hearing held on July 25, 2017.
- Commissioner Court Communications: Twelve (12) people spoke to the Commissioners Court during their August 1, 2017 voting session.

¹ Not all people signed attendance sheets so the actual number of people attending meetings is higher than stated here.

Summary of Transportation and Drainage Comments

Four hundred and thirty-nine (439) comments were received on transportation and drainage issues. Public comments are summarized as follows:

Proposed Road Capacity and Safety Projects (70% of total comments)

- Reimers/Peacock Road – The most commented on project with over 27% of all transportation and drainage comments received concerned the Reimers Peacock Road project. All comments pertain to the support/opposition of the potential inclusion of the project in the November bond election. Seventy-three percent (73%) of the comments oppose the project with 27% supporting.
- Del Valle Added Capacity and Safety Projects – Closely following the Reimers Peacock Road discussion are the added capacity and safety road improvement projects in the Del Valle area of Precinct 4 at 25% of all transportation and drainage comments. Eighty-seven percent (87%) of the comments supported and asked for increased funding to go towards added capacity and safety projects (Elroy Rd., Ross Rd., and Pearce Ln.) mainly in the Del Valle area. Of the comments received concerning road improvement projects within Del Valle, 13% were opposed to improving Elroy Road.
- Hamilton Pool Road Safety Project- Ten percent (10%) of all comments received concerned the support/opposition to the Hamilton Pool Road Safety Project. Sixty-seven percent (67%) of the comments support the project with 33% opposing.
- Pflugerville Area Project support- Seven percent (7%) of all comments concerned projects being proposed in the Pflugerville area. Those comments include support for the Jesse Bohls Rd. safety and added capacity projects, Cameron Rd., Cele Rd. and Hodde Ln projects.
- Additional projects receiving multiple supporting comments include:
 - Harold Green Rd added capacity extension
 - Grand Avenue Parkway added capacity

Proposed Drainage Projects (6% of total comments)

- Six percent (6%) of comments received concerned drainage/flooding projects. Nearly all comments received were from Precinct 4 commenters supporting the need and increased funding for projects in the Precinct. Several comments received expressed concern that the Circuit of the Americas development has increased flooding on surrounding roads. Two comments at the Commissioners Court Voting Session 8/1/17 supported increasing the funding for additional drainage projects in the CBAC recommendation.
- Great Divide Bridge Project- Two comments opposed the project and 3 comments supported the project.

Proposed Bicycle/Pedestrian/Trail Projects (6% of total comments)

- Six percent (6%) of all comments received concerned mostly support for bicycle/pedestrian/trail projects with 46% of those bike/ped./trail comments concerning support to add the Westminster Glen sidewalk project to the project list. No comments opposed the sidewalk project. Two comments voiced concerns about the Walnut Creek Phase III B trail project and two comments supported not removing the Austin to Manor Trail project in the CBAC recommendations.

Against Proposed Bond Election (2% of total comments)

- Nine comments, 2% percent, were received that describe opposition to a bond election. Most commenters expressed a fear of increased taxes.

Other Projects/Miscellaneous (16% of total comments)

- Projects receiving few comments and miscellaneous issues.

Summary of Park and Land Conservation Comments

One hundred and sixty-five (165) comments were received about parks and land conservation issues. A summary of comments and a table organized by topic (see Table 2) are provided below.

There is overwhelming support for the park and land conservation projects proposed by the CBAC

Eighty-five percent (85%) of all comments support the specific projects or types of projects that the CBAC proposed for the bond referendum. Another seven percent (7%) advocate for the improving sports fields at Northeast Metro Park, a project ranked high by the CBAC but not included in the proposed package because of the budgetary limits they worked with.

There is strong support for acquisition of parkland and preservation of open space

A clear majority (53%) support funding the acquisition of more parkland and preservation of open space. This is comprised of comments that advocate for the acquisition of parkland and open space, in general (32%), or specifically for the funding of conservation easements (21%).

There is significant demand for more funds being allocated for park and land conservation projects

Approximately one-quarter (23%) advocate specifically for prioritizing or increasing the amount of funding that is allocated in the proposed bond proposal for parks and land conservation. Recommended amounts range from adding another \$50 million to the package to topping out at \$200 million.

There is significant demand for new or improved sports facilities

One-quarter (24%) of all comments express the need to develop new or improve existing sports complexes. Eight percent (8%) advocate for the Bee Creek Sports Complex², seven percent (7%) advocate for improving the sports fields at Northeast Metro Park and other major county sports complexes, and six percent (6%) advocate for a new sports complex in the Steiner Ranch/Four Points area of Precinct 2.

² One person expressed concern about the impact of the sports complex on the environment, asked that environmental impacts be studied, and that more of the site be developed for non-sports activities.

Summary of Other Bond Related Comments

Twenty three (23) comments were received about other bond-related issues. A summary of comments and a table organized by topic (see Table 3) are provided below.

Almost one-third (30%) of the comments advocate against the bonds

High taxes and cost of living in Austin were the primary reasons given for not supporting the bond package but not wanting to pass on the cost to future generations and the feeling that it is AISD’s turn were also cited.

Other bond-related issues cover a wide variety of topics

- Several comments advocate for a larger bond than the originally targeted amount, and support the longer 5-year time frame for completing bond projects.
- Several comments question the need for an advisory committee, stating county staff should know what is needed.
- Several comments pertain to previous bonds and include asking about the status of existing bond projects and how revenues generated from improved parks is being spent and noting that the Old San Antonio project was not yet completed (because of time required to resolve city-county issues).
