In accordance with the plans, drawings, maps, correspondence and/ or other materials which are attached hereto or referenced herein and made a part of this permit.

Acceptance of this permit requires the Permittee to comply with the following general conditions:

- A. The Permittee must comply with the BMP Maintenance Plan attached to this permit.
- B. The Permittee must allow Travis County to enter the site for purposes of inspecting for compliance with the permit, or for performing any work necessary to bring the site into compliance with the permit.
- C. The Permittee must keep a copy of the permit and BMP Maintenance Plan at the site.
- D. If the property is sold or transferred by the Permittee, this permit and all its requirements and obligations shall be transferred to the purchaser or transferee of the property. The Permittee shall notify Travis County in writing of any sale or transfer of the property within 30 days of such transaction, and a new permit shall be issued to the owner/ operator.
- E. The Permittee must obtain a permit amendment from Travis County prior to modifying the approved BMPs.
- F. The Permittee shall indemnify and hold harmless from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, costs and charges to which Travis County may become subject and which Travis County may have to pay by reason of injury to any person or property, or loss of life or property resulting from, or in any way connected with, the Permittee's acts or negligence under this permit.
- G. The Permittee must perform all activities in accordance with federal, state, or local laws or ordinances.

It is the responsibility of the Permittee to comply with all conditions of this Maintenance Permit.

If Travis County determines that a Permittee is not implementing the approved Maintenance Plan or is not in full and complete compliance with any condition contained in the BMP Maintenance Permit, the Permittee will be notified of the deficiency. From the date that the notice is issued, a Permittee shall have 10 calendar days to prepare a Corrective Action Plan and 45 calendar days from the date that the notice is issued to comply with the Corrective Action Plan, Maintenance Plan or BMP Maintenance Permit condition. If the Permittee fails to comply within this period, Travis County may seek enforcement remedies, including penalties, as provided in the Travis County Code.
