


TELL US WHAT YOU THINK - GET INVOLVED IN THE PLANNING EFFORT


Transportation Plan

Travis County is developing a locally focused transportation plan to identify transportation needs and solutions, incorporate future options and choices, and prioritize improvements in areas outside city limits. This Plan will define priorities through the year 2045, with an emphasis on what we need today and what we will need in the future.

This Plan further defines the transportation component of the Land, Water & Transportation Plan (LWTP) which was adopted in 2014 to balance development and transportation planning with natural resource conservation.

Phase 1 September – December 2016 Public Engagement

We Are All Ears! – We are engaging the public to share background information and gather input on current needs, priorities, and future options.

The first step is to engage the community and gather input! Input from local residents is important to the planning process. Over the next few months, the County will be out in the community asking for your thoughts and opinions.

Phase 2 January - December 2017 Plan Development

We will blend technical data with public input to develop a Draft Plan. We will share the Plan and again engage the public to get feedback.

What we hear from you will help shape the Plan which will guide the County in identifying priorities and future transportation options.

Phase 3 January – March 2018 Plan Revisions and Adoption

We will take what we heard from the public and other transportation partners to refine the Plan and present it to Commissioners Court for adoption.


A Plan to Serve Resident Needs and Priorities

Our top goal is serving Travis County residents. Consequently, before we start developing the plan we want to hear from you, people who travel within and through the County every day. Your input will shape planning efforts and priorities.



A Plan for the Unincorporated Areas

These areas are outside of city limits where the County is responsible for planning, funding, building, and maintaining roads and transportation infrastructure.




A Plan for Future Development

This transportation plan can help direct growth and future development. As growth occurs, developers will understand where transportation corridors will be.



A Plan for Future Growth

Travis County's population is expected to grow from 1.2 million to nearly 1.9 million by the year 2045! We are proactively thinking about how we will get around with this many people living here, as well as others travelling into and through the County daily.



A Plan for Funding

Transportation funding is scarce. We need to identify current and future mobility priorities. This Plan will be used to identify future projects and how best to fund them.



A Plan to Protect Economic Vitality

We recognize that if companies can't get their employees to and from work or deliver goods efficiently, they will not want to move here. We need to be able to move around and in/out of the County to be economically competitive.



A Plan to Protect and Enhance Quality of Life

Residents need a Plan for safe, reliable, and efficient transportation. As population increases, we need mobility options to address congestion and travel times.



A Plan to Address Air Quality

Vehicular travel is a major contributor to air pollution in our region and climate change. We need to carefully consider mobility options that produce less pollution and greenhouse gas emissions, but allow more and more people to move around.
