Executive Summary: The COVID-19 pandemic has created new and challenging issues for jail administrators. Justice Planning produces a daily report that identifies several outcome measures related to the jail population such as Average Daily Population (ADP), jail bookings and releases, and inmates in custody by charge level and offense type. This is a different report, which provides more detailed information regarding the same outcomes, as well as additional outcomes, such as who is in jail and why and personal bond release rates. The following outcome measures are included in this report:

- ADP
 - Month to date (August 1-6, 2020)
 - COVID-19 countermeasure to the end of the current reporting period (March 16-August 6, 2020)
 - Current reporting period (July 31-August 6, 2020)
- Jail bookings and releases
 - Month to date (August 1-6, 2020)
 - COVID-19 countermeasure to the end of the current reporting period (March 16-August 6, 2020)
 - Current reporting period (July 31-August 6, 2020)
- Inmates in custody today (August 6, 2020)
 - Charge level and offense type
 - Excludes inmates waiting for a hospital bed and SWAP participants
- Who is in jail and why (August 6, 2020)
 - Inmates with a hold
 - Inmates serving a sentence
 - Pretrial inmates

Average Daily Population March 16-August 6, 2020




SUMMARY¹:

- Month to date, the Average Daily Population (ADP) for has increased 2% from August 1 (1,798) to August 6 (1,833).
- Since the COVID-19 order to the end of the current reporting period, the ADP decreased 17% from March 16 (2,164) to August 6 (1,833).
- For the current reporting period, the ADP increased 2% from July 31 (1,805) to August 6 (1,833).

Bookings and Releases


Jail Bookings March 16-August 6, 2020



SUMMARY:

- Month to date, jail bookings increased 0% from August 1 (58) to August 6 (58).
- Since the COVID-19 order to the end of the current reporting period, jail bookings decreased 43% from March 16 (102) to August 6 (58).
- For the current reporting period, jail bookings increased 23% from July 31 (47) to August 6 (58).

Jail Releases March 16-July 30, 2020




SUMMARY²:

- Month to date, jail releases increased 103% from August 1 (30) to August 6 (61).
- Since the COVID-19 order to the end of the current reporting period, jail releases decreased 50% from March 16 (121) to August 6 (61).
- For the current reporting period, releases increased 33% from July 31 (46) to August 6 (61).


Summary:

- There are 1,832 inmates in custody today, August 6, 2020.
- 92% (1,692) have a felony as their highest charge.
- 8% (140) have a misdemeanor as their highest charge.
- 48% (866) have a violent charge as their highest charge.
- 52% (946) have a non-violent charge as their highest charge.
